Dear Members,

The CPC Athlete Council has made the decision to have our election earlier in 2026 since we currently have had two vacancies that we wanted to fill as well as meeting the requirements of our regular elections post Winter Games.

Therefore, the Canadian Paralympic Committee (CPC) is currently seeking nominations for its Athletes' Council for **one (1) Winter Sport representative and three (3) Summer Sport representatives for 4-year term, and one (1) Summer Sport Representative for a 2-year term.**

The CPC Athletes' Council is an elected group of current and retired Paralympians that serves as the collective voice and advocate for the best interests of Canada's Paralympic athletes and the Paralympic movement within Canada. The CPC Athletes' Council works to provide input and recommendations from an athlete's perspective to the CPC staff, committees, and Board of Directors.

As such, the CPC is notifying you of the nominations and elections process for the Athletes' Council.

A completed nomination package includes:

- Nomination form;
- Letter of support from the National Sport Organization (NSO) with whom the athlete is affiliated;
- Background letter and résumé from the nominated athlete, including involvement in the Paralympic Movement.

### **Eligibility for Nomination:**

To be eligible for election, an individual must:

- be eligible to be competing at French Alps 2030 Paralympic Winter Games or Los Angeles 2028 Paralympic Summer Games; or
- have competed in the previous two editions of the relevant Paralympic Games to their sport; or
- has previously competed at a relevant Paralympic Games and has officially retired from sport within the last eight years of the day the nomination is submitted; and
- be in good standing with their National Sport Organization, receive their National Sport Organization endorsement, and must not have any previous anti-doping rule violations.



No more than one candidate per National Sport Organization (NSO) member sport on the Paralympic sport programme may stand for election. If multiple candidates from one sport are nominated, CPC staff will notify the candidates immediately for self-selection of a representative.

To note, that Volleyball Canada and Nordic Canada still have active members on the council and therefore would not be able to nominate candidates for this round of nomination.

If a single candidate cannot be agreed upon by an NSO member sport, no candidates from that sport will be nominated.

The sports of Sitting Volleyball and Para Nordic may not submit nominations as they are already represented on the Athletes' Council.

A completed nomination includes: (1) Nomination form, (2) Letter of support from the National Sport Organization in which the Athlete is affiliated, (3) Background letter and résumé from the nominated athlete, including involvement in the Paralympic Movement.



## Call for Nominations & Election Process

A call for nominations for Council members will be issued to athletes at least 90 days before the final Athletes' Council face-to-face meeting at the end of a 4-year term.

Candidates can be nominated by any athlete, or nominate themselves to their NSOs, in the manner described in the call for candidates, subject to the eligibility outlined in "Eligibility for Nomination" of the above terms.

Sixty (60) days before the final meeting of the Athletes' Council 4-year term, nominations will be closed, and qualifying candidates will be announced electronically to the athletes within one week.

Athletes are eligible to vote for the members of the Athletes' Council in the manner described in the call for candidates. Successful candidates will be announced 30 days before the final Athletes' Council face-to-face meeting at the end of its 4-year term.

The election procedure above can be summarized as follows:

1. 90 days before the final Athletes' Council meeting of term, a call for nominations will be released.
2. 60 days before the final Athletes' Council meeting of term, nominations will be closed and the qualifying nominees will be announced, election begins.
3. 30 days before the final Athletes' Council meeting of term, voting closes and successful members are announced.
