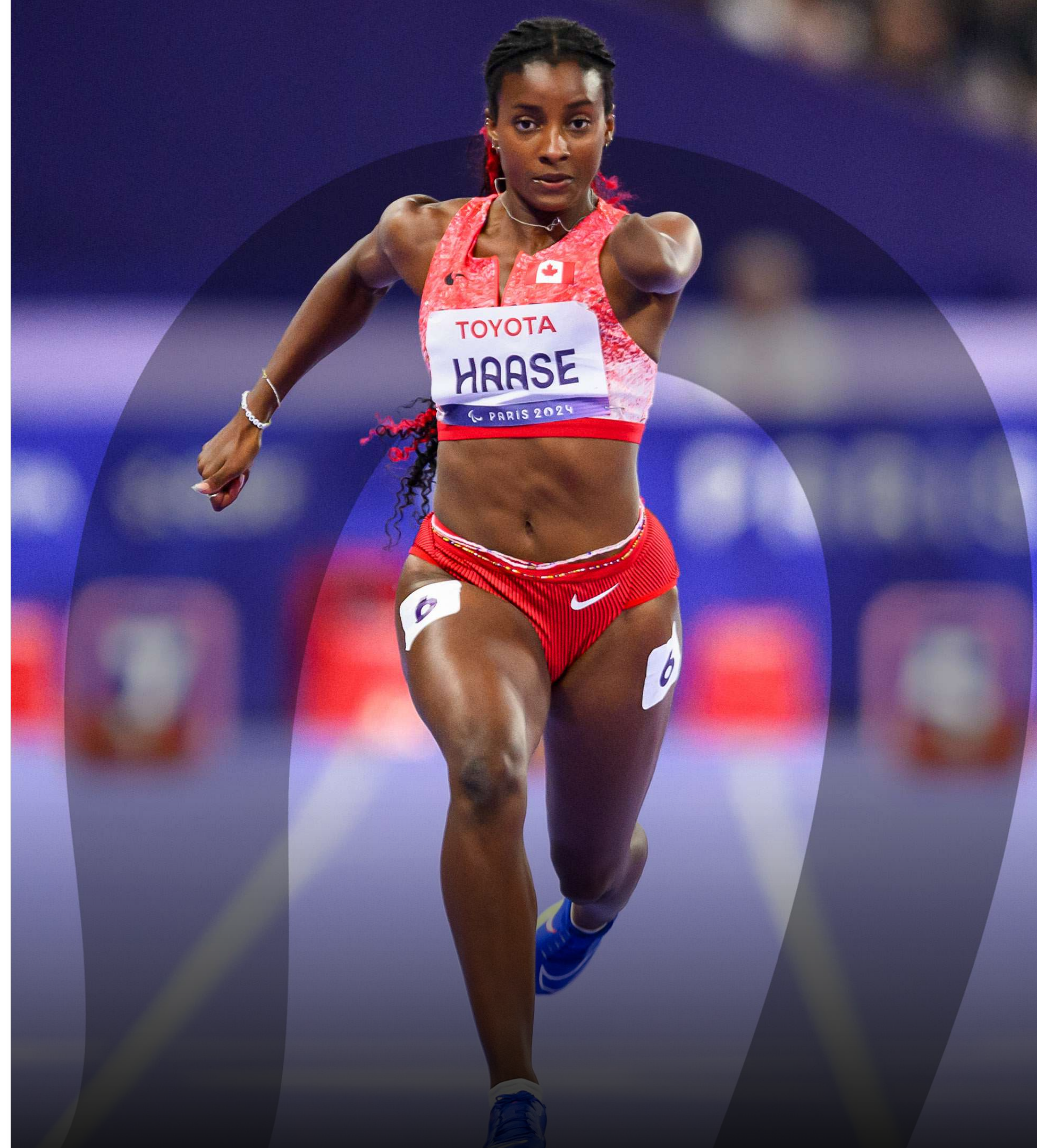
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INTRODUCTION

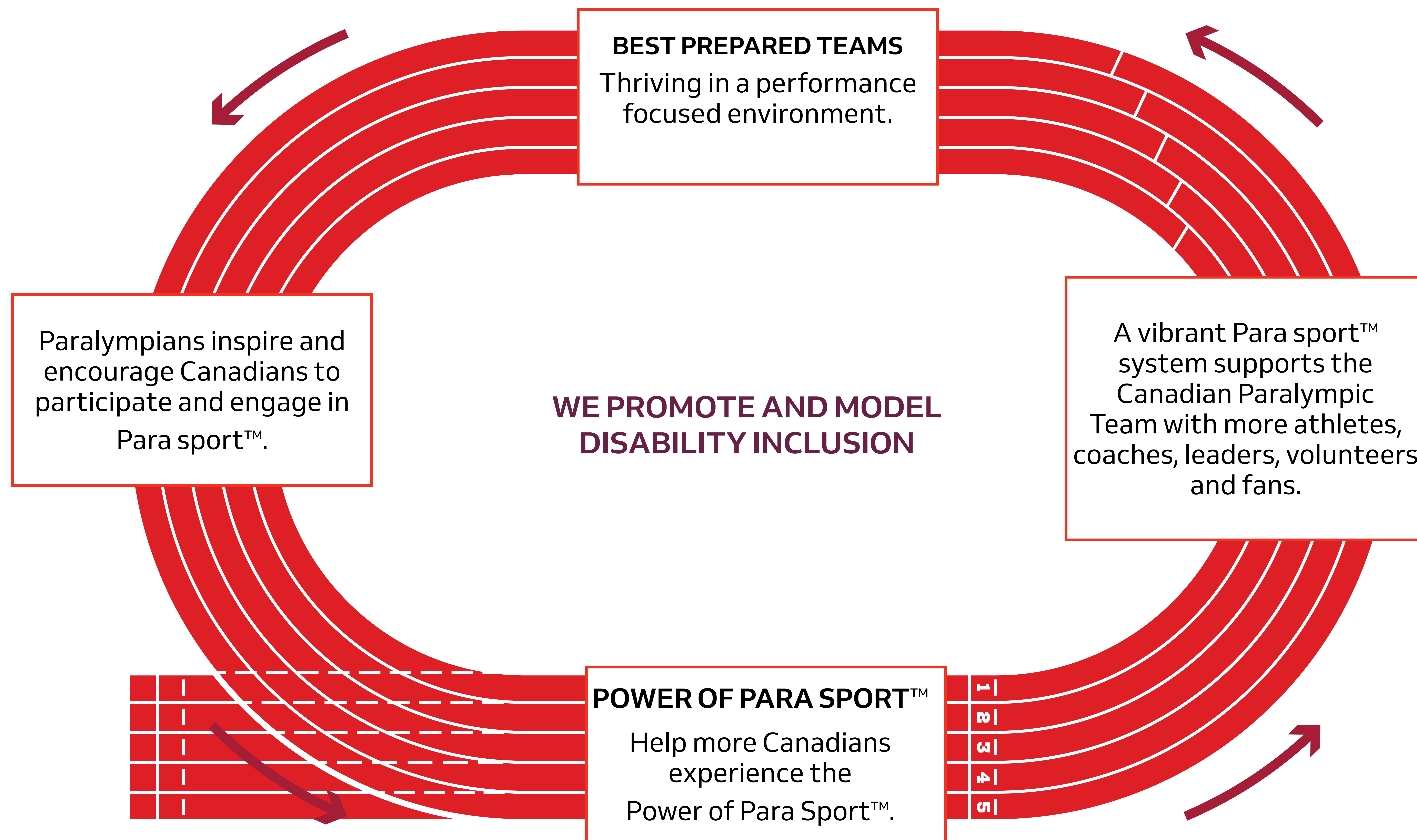
Talent is everywhere in Canada; access and opportunity is not. We all need this to change.

Our vision is bold: an inclusive world through Paralympic sport. To achieve it, we are focused on two strategic priorities: supporting the Best Prepared Teams to succeed on the world stage and enabling more people to experience the Power of Para Sport™.

Best Prepared Teams is our commitment to working alongside our sport partners to ensure athletes have the preparation, support, and culture required to compete at the highest level of international sport. When Canadian athletes are ready and prepared, they do more than win medals – they fuel national pride, increase participation and accelerate the growth of the Paralympic movement.

Power of Para Sport™ is how we turn that momentum into opportunity. Together with partners and members, we will confront barriers with urgency – building the systems, infrastructure, environments, and audience that will open doors for good.
